**REMOTE NOTARY AUTHORIZATION**

The Secretary of State has reviewed your application to perform remote online notarizations and approves the use of the technology you intend to use.

You are authorized to perform remote online notarizations from the date of your authorization through the expiration of your current commission. However, as set forth in 49 O.S., § 2, you may **not** perform ANY notarial act unless and until your bond, official seal, oath of office, and loyalty oath have been received and approved by the Secretary of State.

As set forth in 49 O.S., § 204(F), “[t]he renewal of a notary public's commission pursuant to Section 1 of Title 49 of the Oklahoma Statutes shall not constitute the renewal of the notary public's authorization to perform remote online notarizations under this section.”

Your authorization to perform remote online notarizations terminates if your name changes during the term of your notary public commission AND you elect to use your new name under a new commission.
